

## Gloss Photo Paper Instructions

## **Before Printing**


- · Only print using an inkjet printer.
- Handle paper by the edges to avoid getting fingerprints on glossy printable surface.

TIP: Print your photo or project on plain paper first to ensure correct size and image position. (Use Fast or Draft mode to conserve ink).

## **Printing**


1. Load paper into tray according to your printer's manual.

TIP: We recommend single-sheet feeding rather than stacking in tray.



Front Loading Printers

Load with glossy side facing down



Top Loading Printers

Load with glossy side facing forward

- 2. Select Print within menu.
- **3.** Click Preferences, Properties, or Options button (depending on your printer):
  - Choose 'Portrait' or 'Landscape' Orientation and 'Letter' Size.
  - Set Media Type to Everyday Gloss, Semi-Gloss or Advanced Photo Papers.

TIP: Refer to your printer manual for specific setting for your printer model.

## **Storage**

- Store paper in packaging, flat and away from moisture and humidity.
- Avoid exposing printed or unprinted paper to bright lights or direct sunlight for extended periods of time.
